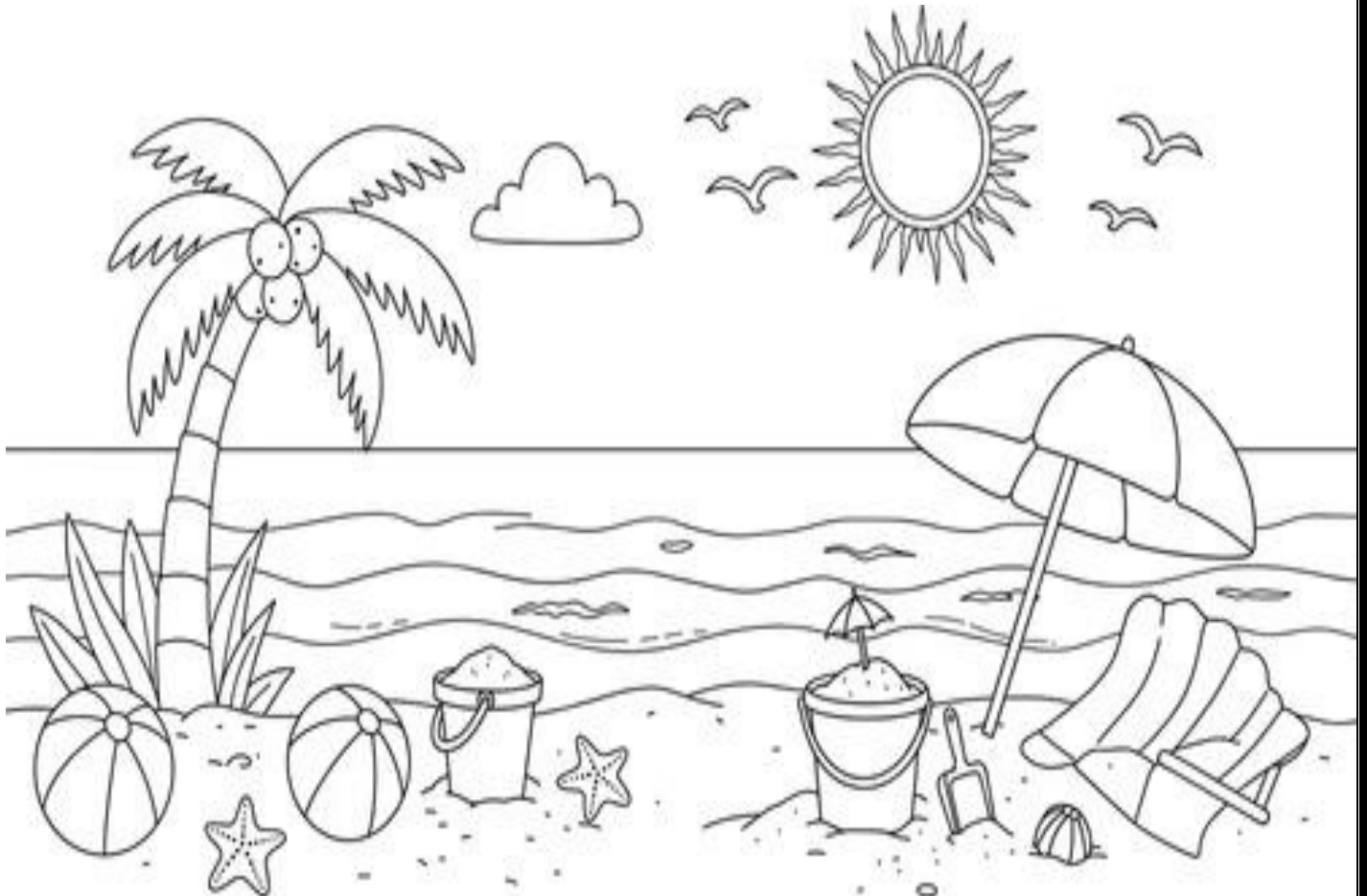


Sunbeams dance and the school bells ring,

SUBJECTS	ASSIGNMENT
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Reading on a daily basis should become a routine as brushing your teeth before bedtime. Reading for pleasure on a daily basis can improve fluency and nurture a love for reading”. So read one page of the English Text Book and Story Books. • Write one page everyday in a separate 4 lined thin notebook to increase writing speed. Also underline 4 nouns. • Listen to a short moral story from your parents. Draw your favourite character from that story in scrap book. • Grammar Hunt: Find 10 Proper Nouns and 10 Common Nouns from your favourite story and list them in scrap book.
Hindi	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • सप्ताह में 3 बार अपनी रफ पुस्तिका में एक पेज सुलेख करें। • सप्ताह में दो बार अपनी मनपसंद एक कहानी पढ़ें एवं कहानी का संदेश समझें और घर के बड़ों को सुनाएँ। • शब्दावली: किन्हीं 10 विलोम शब्दों का चित्र सहित अपनी रफ पुस्तिका में अभ्यास करें। • सृजनात्मकता: अपनी पसंद की कोई एक कविता याद करें और उसका विडियो रिकॉर्ड करें।
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write and learn the tables from 2-20 in your rough notebook • Abacus Fun: Create a simple 3-digit Abacus using cardboard and beads/pasta to show the place value of numbers up to 999. • Real-World Math: Help your parents check the bill after grocery shopping and find the total.
EVS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plantation: Plant a sapling in a small pot and water it everyday. • Eco-Warrior Mission: For one week, try to follow the 3 R's: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Reduce: Turn off lights when leaving a room. ○ Reuse: Turn an old glass jar into a pen stand. ○ Recycle: Keep paper and plastic waste separate. • Healthy Plate: Draw a large circle (a plate). Cut out pictures of different foods from old magazines and paste them on the plate to make a "Balanced Meal." Label the fruits, vegetables, and pulses.

Artificial Intelligence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After your given visits, use any AI app, tell the AI one thing you saw and ask it to help you write a 3-line poem about it. Eg.- I saw a tall Giraffe today. Can you help me write a funny poem about it? • Use a Voice Assistant (like Siri or Google) to find out the weather in three different Indian cities.
Physical Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The "Balance Master" Log: Practice standing on one leg (tree pose) while brushing your teeth or waiting for breakfast. Try to increase your time each day. Keep a log of how many seconds you can hold the pose for both your left and right legs. • Sun Salutation: Learn the Surya Namaskar and do it every morning. (atleast 2 everyday)
G.K.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know Your Leaders: Learn the names of the current President of India- Smt. Draupadi Murmu, the Vice President of India- C.P. Radhakrishnan, the Prime Minister of India- Shri Narendra Modi, the Chief Minister of M.P.- Shri Mohan Yadav • The State Explorer: Choose any one Indian State (other than your own). Find out and learn: The Capital City, The Main Language Spoken, One Famous Festival and One Famous Dish
Dance & Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rhythmic Move: Record a dance video of yourself on your favourite song. Ask your parents or siblings to join you. • Sound Scavenger Hunt: Sit quietly in your balcony or park for 5 minutes. Close your eyes and list 5 different sounds you heard (e.g., a bird chirping, a car horn, the wind). • Learn and Recite Ram Stuti, Hanuman Chalisa and 5 Shlokas of Geeta everyday with your parents.
Value Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gratitude Journaling: Ask the child to write three things that are grateful for every Sunday in your rough notebook. These can be as simple as “a sunny day” or “playing with my friend”. • Helpful Hands: Help your parents to refill the water bottles and keep them in the fridge.

Social Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The "Civic Hero" Photo Essay: Appreciating Community Workers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Activity: "Invisible Heroes" Appreciation. ○ The Task: Identify a person who helps the community but is often overlooked (e.g., the school bus driver, the person who sweeps the street, the security guard). ○ The Output: Write a "Thank You" note or draw a picture of them in action. Write three sentences about how the neighbourhood would be different if that person didn't do their job.
Summer Visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zoo Trip: Visit the Gwalior zoo to see animals and their habitats. Identify 3 animals that like to stay in the water to beat the heat. • A Local Supermarket: Go grocery shopping with your parents. Find 3 fruits that are only available in summer.
Art & Craft	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Punctillism (Dot Art): Create a landscape by using cotton swabs (earbuds) dipped in paint made entirely of dots. This helps with patience and precision. (Do this in your scrap book) • Paper Weaving Mat: Take two different coloured sheets of paper (or old magazine covers). Cut one into vertical strips and other into a 'base' with slits. Weave the strips in an 'over-and-under' pattern to create a colourful checkered mat. Once finished, decorate it.
S.T.E.M. FUN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shadow Tracking: On a sunny day, place a toy on a piece of paper outside. Trace its shadow at 10:00 AM, 1:00 PM, and 4:00 PM. Observe how the shadow moves and changes length.
