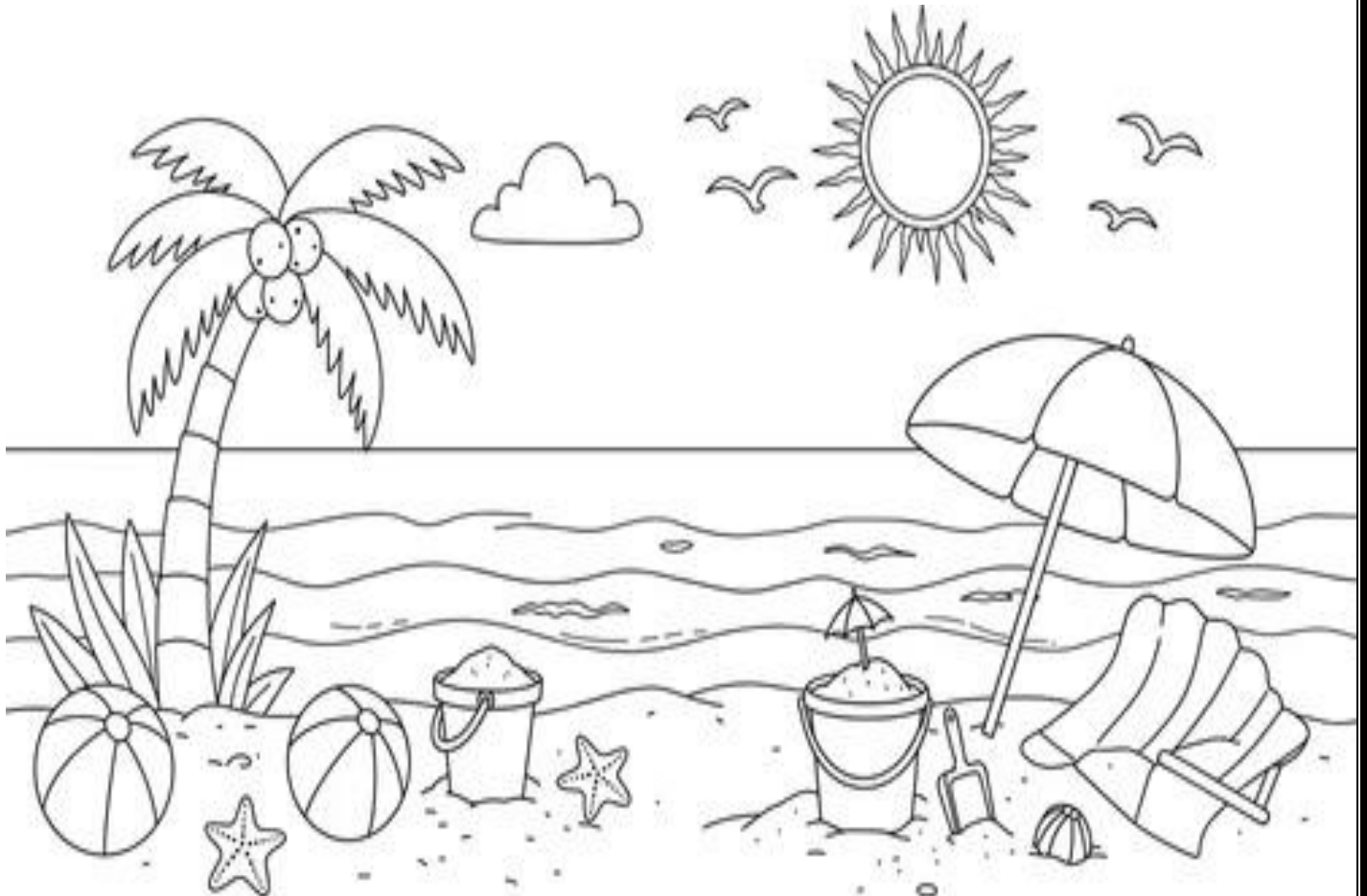


Sunbeams dance and the school bells ring,

<u>SUBJECTS</u>	<u>ASSIGNMENT</u>
<b>English</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Reading on a daily basis should become a routine as brushing your teeth before bedtime. Reading for pleasure on a daily basis can improve fluency and nurture a love for reading”. So read one page of the English Text Book or an English Newspaper.</li> <li>• Write one page everyday in a separate 1 lined thin <b>notebook</b> to increase writing speed. Also underline 2 difficult words and write their word meanings everyday.</li> <li>• <b>Grammar Quest:</b> Prepare tenses chart <b>in your scrap book</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Hindi</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• सप्ताह में 3 बार अपनी रफ पुस्तिका में एक पेज सुलेख करें।</li> <li>• <u>नन्हे पत्रकार-साक्षात्कार:</u> अपने घर के किसी बड़े (दादा-दादी या नाना-नानी) का साक्षात्कार लें। उनसे उनके बचपन के खेल, स्कूल और उनकी पसंदीदा मिठाई के बारे में पूछें। इन जानकारियों को एक अनुच्छेद के रूप में अपनी रफ पुस्तिका में लिखें।</li> <li>• <u>विज्ञापन बनाएँ:</u> यदि आपको अपना एक 'आइसक्रीम पार्लर' या 'खिलौनों की दुकान' खोलनी हो, तो आप उसका प्रचार कैसे करेंगे? अपनी स्कैप बुक में आकर्षक चित्र बनाकर एक सुंदर विज्ञापन तैयार करें और एक बढ़िया 'स्लोगन' भी लिखें।</li> </ul>
<b>Maths</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write and learn the tables from 2-20 in your <b>rough notebook</b></li> <li>• <b>Travel Log Math:</b> (Large Number Operations) If you are travelling during the holidays, track the distance. Note the starting odometer reading of your car and the ending reading. Calculate the total distance travelled. If the car gives a mileage of 15 km per litre, calculate how many litres of fuel was used. <b>(Do this in your rough notebook)</b></li> <li>• <b>Budgeting for a Party:</b> (Unitary Method) Plan a small party for 5 friends with a total budget of Rs.1000. Make a list of items (snacks, drinks, decorations). Find the price of each item and ensure the total stays within Rs. 1000. Show your calculations clearly in a "Budget Table". <b>(Do this in your scrap book)</b></li> </ul>
<b>Science</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The Magic of Static Electricity:</b> (Energy and Force) Rub a plastic comb or a balloon against your hair or a woollen sweater for 30 seconds. Hold it near tiny bits of paper. Watch the paper "jump" to the comb. Write a brief explanation <b>in your scrap book</b> about <b>Static Electricity</b> and how it acts as a non-contact force.</li> <li>• <b>Waste Segregation Hero (Conservation):</b> For two days, monitor the waste produced in your kitchen. Create a chart showing <b>Biodegradable</b> (peels, leftover food) vs. <b>Non-biodegradable</b> (plastic wraps, tins) waste. Write 3 ways your family can reduce plastic waste at home <b>in your scrap book</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Social Science</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Neighborhood Map:</b> Draw a simple map from your house to the nearest landmark (like a grocery store, park, or milk booth) in <b>scrap book</b>. Use symbols for trees, houses, and roads.</li> <li>• <b>Festival Scrapbook:</b> Choose any one festival coming up or one you recently celebrated. Draw the special food eaten during that festival and the clothes people wear in <b>scrap book</b>.</li> </ul>

<u>SUBJECTS</u>	<u>ASSIGNMENT</u>
<b>Artificial Intelligence</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The "AI Detective" Scavenger Hunt (AI in Daily Life):</b> Look around your home and your parents' phones. Find 5 things that use AI (e.g., Alexa/Siri, Netflix recommendations, Google Maps, or Face ID). Create a table listing the Name of the AI, What it does, and How it helps you. <b>(Do this in your scrap book)</b></li> <li>• Use an AI app to find out the meanings of 2 Idioms everyday and frame atleast two sentences and write <b>in your scrap book.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Physical Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The 7-Day "Gully Games" Project:</b> Step away from screens and play one traditional outdoor game (like Kho-Kho, Kabbadi, Hopscotch/Stapu, or Hide and Seek) for at least 30 minutes daily.</li> <li>• <b>Sun Salutation:</b> Learn the Surya Namaskar and do it every morning. (atleast 5 everyday)</li> </ul>
<b>G.K.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Indian Currency:</b> Paste duplicate Indian Notes <b>in your scrap book</b> and write their colour and the monument which is imprinted on the note.</li> <li>• <b>Heritage Hunter:</b> Identify one UNESCO World Heritage site in India. Find out who built it and why it is protected today.</li> </ul>
<b>Dance &amp; Music</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Lyrical Handwriting:</b> Write down the lyrics of a patriotic song or a folk song in your best handwriting. Decorate the borders with musical notes. <b>(Do this in your scrap notebook)</b></li> <li>• <b>Expressive Art (Abhinaya):</b> Record yourself performing 30-seconds dance move three times, but change your facial expression each time to match a different "Navarasa" (emotion): Joy, Bravery, and Wonder.</li> <li>• Learn and Recite Ram Stuti, Hanuman Chalisa and 5 Shlokas of Geeta everyday with your parents.</li> </ul>
<b>Value Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The "Little Acts" Secret Mission:</b> Perform one "Secret Act of Kindness" for a family member every day for three days (e.g., making their bed, filling their water bottle, or organizing their shoes) without telling them it was you.</li> <li>• <b>The "No-Complaint" Day:</b> Challenge yourself to go a full 24 hours without complaining about anything (the weather, food, or chores). If you feel a complaint coming, try to find one positive thing to say instead.</li> </ul>

<b>SUBJECTS</b>	<b>ASSIGNMENT</b>
<b>Social Activity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Social Detective Letter:</b> Identify one problem in your neighbourhood (e.g., a broken street light, a park with litter). Write a formal "Mock Letter" to the local Municipal Corporation (Ward Councillor). <b>Focus: Learning the formal letter structure and the power of a citizen's voice.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Summer Visit</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The "Past to Present" Heritage Visit:</b> Visit a local monument, fort, or historical building. Find out the year it was built and what materials were used (e.g., red sandstone, marble, or lime plaster).</li> <li>• <b>Community Hero Visit: The Fire Station or Police Station:</b> With an adult, visit a local service station. Ask an officer about their daily routine. Write down the emergency number and list three safety tips they give you for your home.</li> </ul>
<b>Art &amp; Craft</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Glass Jar Lanterns:</b> By using empty jam or pickle jars, tissue paper, and glue, Clean the jar and paste small pieces of colored tissue paper all over the outside. Once dry, place a battery-operated tea light inside to create a stained-glass effect.</li> <li>• <b>Pista Shell Flower Wall Hanging:</b> By using cleaned pistachio shells, a cardboard circle, and glue. Glue the shells in concentric circles on the cardboard to form a "Dahlia" flower. Paint the shells in vibrant colors once the glue is dry.</li> </ul>
<b>S.T.E.M. FUN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Kitchen Chemistry: The Invisible Ink (Science):</b> Use lemon juice or milk as "ink" and a cotton swab to write a secret message on paper. Once dry, have an adult help you hold it near a light bulb or use a warm iron to reveal the message. <b>STEM Challenge:</b> Explain why the "ink" turns brown when heated (oxidation). <b>Deliverable:</b> The secret message and a short explanation of the result.</li> </ul>
